

## Personally Administered Items

### Common Items

Adrenaline
Anaesthetic Inj: Bupivacaine, Instillagel, Lidocaine, Marcain, Xylocaine
Anti-nausea Inj: Metoclopramide, Stemetil
Atropine
Benzylpenicillin (+ Water For Inj)
Chlorphenamine, Cyclizine
Contraception: - Coils, eg Mirena - Depo-Provera (Medroxyprogesterone)
Emla Cream
Epipen
<i>Flus – purchased only</i>
Furosemide ampules
GlucaGen HypoKit
GnRH Inj: Decapeptyl (Triptorelin), Prostag (Leuprorelin), Zoladex (Goserelin)
<i>Hep A: Avaxim, Havrix, Vaqta, ViATIM (+ Typhoid)</i>
<i>Hep A+B: Ambirix, Twinrix</i>
<i>Hep B: Engerix</i> <i>For “at risk” only</i>

Inclisiran (Leqvio)
Minims + Oxybuprocaine / Tetracaine
Neuroleptic inj: Depixol, Flupentixol, Modecate
Pessaries (PVC & Vinyl) – <i>not all</i>
Prolia (Denosumab)
Revaxis*
Sodium Chloride ampules – <i>injection only</i>
Steristrip: 6mm x 75mm – <i>only these</i>
Steroid Inj: Depo-Medrone (Methylprednisolone), Efcortisol, Kenalog (Triamcinalone), Metoject, Myocrisin, Methotrexate
Sutures – <i>not all</i> : eg W1615T, W9074, W9516T, W9962, 1666H, 662G, W320BG
Testosterone Inj: Nebido, Sustanon
<i>Typhoid: Typhim VI, Vivotif Cap</i>
Vitamin Inj: Hydroxocobalamin
Voltarol Injection
Water For Injection

\*Revaxis. School-leavers: use free stock from Central Supply.  
Adults: use purchased stock

*Red: = Volume Vaccine, do not print prescription*

### This is not an exhaustive list: if in doubt, check

#### Guidelines:

- Only claim PURCHASED PAIs. Do not claim for PAIs from Central Supply or items provided by the pharmacy
- Ensure everyone knows what is claimable
- Do not issue prescription to patient
- Only issue prescription on the day of the procedure
- Only issue prescription for the items used on the day
- Use approved Practice templates to record procedures
